If non-urgent refer child to CPCH intake (604-742-3476 or intake@canuckplace.org) or request a consultation with CPCH Nurse Practitioner 604-742-3478

Consider re-referral if young adult's fragility/ instability changes Young adult/family appropriate for <u>CPCH</u> <u>program</u> or <u>CPCH</u> consultation

Initiate contact with Advanced Practice Nurse/ Nurse Practitioner to assess

- · key IH clinicians currently involved
- Health zone status of child and current concerns/symptoms/needs
- · Family resources
- Known child/family Goals of care (GOC)
- Available services (both CPCH and community)
- Need for inter-agency and/or further program referral (i.e. IH Palliative CNS, home care, etc.)
- Assess need for further discussions with child/family
- Plan interdisciplinary multi-team meeting as needed.

## CPCH to:

- 1. Join <u>IH Whole Community Palliative Rounds</u> in closest community to Child's/Family's home when appropriate (complete Palliative SBAR)
- 2. Determine appropriate role for CPCH based on young adult's GOC
- 3. Co-Creation of Collaborative Care Plan with IH and advanced directives and/or IH learning/education needs for PPC support (CPCH to support via ECHO sessions, zoom, debriefs, etc.)
- 4. Establish reciprocal ongoing communication pathway (zoom, rounds, phone, email) and pattern (daily, weekly, monthly) for changes in care plan and ongoing care between both child/family and care providers.
  - Establish with the family a key care provider to provide child/family relevant team updates to support consistent messaging and continuity.
